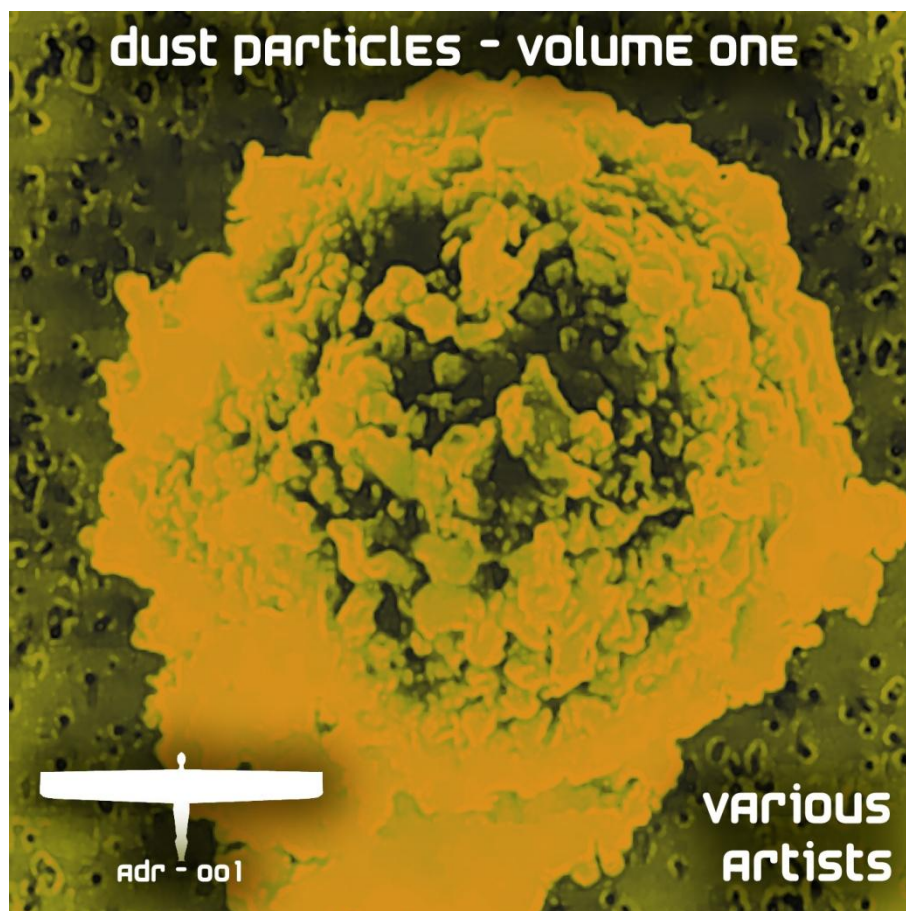

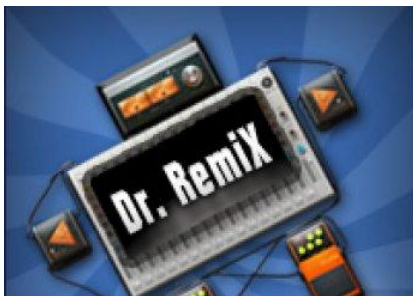

Dust Particles, Volume One, is the first release by new netlabel, Angel Dust Records. It's a Various Artists EP, showcasing 6 specially selected tracks of dub and dubstep that can be found in the Creative Commons Licensed Music community. All the artists have been played at some time on one of Pete Cogle's [Dub Zone](#) or [Dubstep Zone](#) podcasts, and have been a favourite with the listeners.



Living in Amsterdam with a strong passion for multi-media creations, 46 year old [Dr. RemiX](#) creates a reggae-ish tune every once in a while and shares his music for free on the world wide web...

Dr. RemiX creates his music at home with an old 2 octave Oxygen8 MIDI keyboard and any music creation software he can lay his hands on.

"For me making music, or any other artform I practice, is purely hobby/ home entertainment oriented. It's like solving a crossword puzzle, you fill in a few blanks and new solutions or possibilities appear. I always have that great feeling of excitement once I think the puzzle is solved, that's my reward!"

The name Dr. RemiX was given to him by his Beatclub students in an Amsterdam youthcenter. The youngsters found his beats Dr. Dré sounding and as his real name is Remi, the name Dr. RemiX was an inescapable AKA fact.

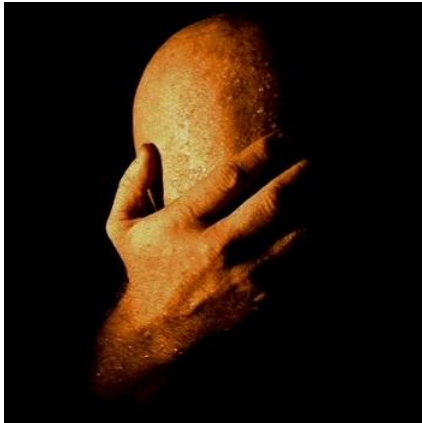

[Baby Arm Sound System](#) is the product of an independent musician, composer and producer based in northern Arizona. Once engrossed in life of live musicianship, Baby Arm Sound System is a studio affair endeavouring toward ever sparser, darker, deeper and expansive realms of bass-driven reggae and dub. The music draws from a lifetime love of reggae music; prominent influences include Lee Perry and the Upsetters, Roots Radics, Sly and Robbie, Midnite, Augustus Pablo, Jackie Mittoo, Dennis Bovell, Singers and Players and many others.

[Phoniandflore](#) (aka [PAF](#)) is based in Périgueux, France, and started to play music at the age of 8. He lists his influences as Improvisator Dub, Burning Spear, Massive Attack, Interlope, U2 & Salif Keita. Apart from his own experiments in dub, he also works with the [Outa Steppaz](#). [Secret Archives of the Vatican](#) are a collective, comprising of *The Keeper Of The Archives*, *Uncle Riotous*, *The Talking Dog* and *Ginger Shinobe the Ginger Ninja*, among others. They originate in Croydon, South London, but have members in both England and Wales.

Their music is usually described as **Transglobal Breakbeat Dub Science** as it contains elements of many genres: breakbeat, dub, dubstep, drumstep, triphop, drum and bass, Indian, Arabian and Turkish musics and many more. They've played live at various festivals in the UK and in Morocco and have contributed tracks to several compilations worldwide as well as releasing their own CDs and downloads.
